

Crating: Space is limited in the building no crating will be allowed in side. There is space for screen houses and tents on the grounds.

Directions

From the south - Take route 295 North to exit 28 Bath/Brunswick route 1 North. In Warren turn left onto route 90. Follow route 90 to route 1 in Rockport. Turn left onto route 1 North. Follow route 1 to route 52 in Camden. Turn left and take route 52 to junction of route 173 (Drake Corner Store). Turn right on 173/Beach Road. In 1/2 mile turn right onto Calderwood Lane (dirt). In 1/4 mile turn right at yellow Wag It mailbox.

From the west - Take route 3/202 North. In Liberty turn right onto route 173. Remain on route 173 into Lincolville. After passing Drake Corner Store travel 1/2 mile and turn right onto Calderwood Lane (dirt). In 1/4 mile turn right at yellow Wag It mail box.

From the north - Take route 1 South to Lincolville Beach. Turn left onto route 173. Remain on route 173 for aprox 4.5 miles. Turn left onto Calderwood Lane (dirt). In 1/4 mile turn right at yellow Wag It mailbox.

Jump Heights

Dogs are not required to be measured. However, judges have the option of measuring any dog prior if the dog appears to be entered in a group lower than might be indicated by his or her registered shoulder height. Jump heights may also be modified or the jump exercise excused entirely based on physical challenges (such as age, body type, or disability such as blindness or the use of a "mobility device") that a particular dog may face.

- Shoulder height under 12 inches.....Jump 4 inches
- Shoulder height 12 inches to under 16 inches.....Jump 8 inches
- Shoulder height 16 inches to under 20 inchesJump 12 inches
- Shoulder height 20 inches and overJump 16 inches

Level A & B Classes

Level A classes are for teams that have not yet completed their title in that level.
Level B classes are for teams that have completed their title in that level.

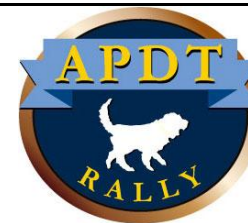

Notice to Competitors

Entry

Competitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of APDT Rally Obedience rules and regulations including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry:

- ◆ This trial is open to all dogs being at least six months of age, except bitches in season or dogs with disabilities, injuries or illnesses which may cause the dog pain or great discomfort, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression that threaten the safety of other dogs or humans.
- ◆ All dogs must be registered with APDT Rally to compete. A one-time registration form is included and must be submitted **DIRECTLY to the RallyO Coordinator** (NOT to trial hosting organization)
- ◆ Dogs must be shown by a member of the owner's immediate family: mother, father, spouse, life partner, sibling, child, grandparent, or grandchild.
- ◆ Owners with disabilities are encouraged to compete. Any necessary modifications to the exercises must be provided by the handler to the judge and approved by the judge.
- ◆ Safety shall always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times. Handlers, through entry at this event, accept full responsibility for themselves and the actions of their dogs.
- ◆ All competitors through entry at this event waive any and all rights relative to video broadcast of this event. Competitors shall have the right to videotape portions of this event for their personal use only. No portion of this event may be videotaped for commercial or other purposes. All video, broadcast, and telecast rights for this event are the exclusive property of the APDT or the trial host(s).
- ◆ The organizing committee may refuse any entry for any reason.

Refund Policy

- ◆ THERE SHALL BE NO REFUND for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of reason for such dismissal. There will be no refunds if the trial has to be cancelled for any reason.
- ◆ Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$30.00 service charge for returned checks. Payment of entry fees and service charges shall be made in cash or money order within 30 days of postmark of notice of returned check where notification is received after event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice result in cancellation of event results for all classes for the registration number(s) of delinquent entry/entries. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification, or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event or entry is canceled without recourse by owner/handler.
- ◆ No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strike or any other cause beyond the control of the organizers.

Grounds Rules

- ◆ Only dogs owned by those entered in the trial may be present on the grounds.
- ◆ Dogs will remain on leash except when appropriate in the ring or while in the fenced play field.
- ◆ Exhibitors will to the best of their ability respect the personal space of other dogs.
- ◆ Officials and host retain the right to remove any person or dog from the grounds due to disturbances or safety issues.
- ◆ Retractable leashes and electric collars are not allowed on the grounds.
- ◆ Wag It is a smoke free campus
- ◆ Please pick up after your dog and yourself.

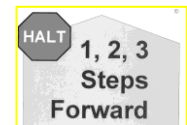
Rally-O is a new sport which consists of a sequence of stations, run as a heel-work course by a handler and dog, where a sign at each station indicates an obedience exercise which the team must perform. Rally is designed to be more relaxed than precision competitive Obedience, focusing instead on attitude and enthusiasm, while the variety of exercises and courses allows you to show off your versatility and teamwork. Rally is intended to promote positive relationships between dogs and owners based on trust and mutual respect. Dogs and handlers should both appear to be enjoying the competition and each other's company.

APDT Rally encourages participation by ALL dogs – purebred or mixed breed, pets or titled champions. Handlers are allowed to encourage their dogs in the ring using verbal praise, petting, and even food rewards just as they would in a good training session. The dogs must perform the exercises correctly and there should be a practiced smooth flow to the performance.

Rally courses, depending on the competition level, consist of 18 to 22 stations, laid out in a numbered pattern (like an agility course), performed on-leash in Level 1 or off-leash in Level 2 (Level 1 title is required to compete at Level 2). Also like agility, handlers get to walk the course and familiarize themselves with the pattern without their dog before running the course. During their run, the dog and handler move through the course in heel position, performing each exercise in turn. The highest scores will be earned by teams who move smoothly through the course, completing each exercise accurately with a minimum of commands, and with high enthusiasm and good attitude. Praise and/or verbal encouragement upon completion of exercises are allowed, and extra commands during exercises are minimally penalized. Rally is fun and interesting to watch as the individual style of each team can really show through.

There are as many as 58 different stations, which might be seen in a Rally course, primarily variations on basic heel exercises and other Obedience skills. Many of the stations involve activities you are probably familiar with; such as *Slow/Normal/Fast Pace Heel, Halt, Left/Right/About Turn, and Finish Right/Left*. Others are simple extensions, such as *270° and 360° Right/Left Turns, Straight Figure Eight, and Send over Jumps*. A few of the other interesting stations include:

- *Call Front - Forward Left:* the handler stops his forward motion and calls the dog to the front position, then moves forward while commanding the dog to move left into heel position falling into step with the handler.
- *Halt - 1, 2, 3 Steps Forward:* After a halt, the handler takes one step forward, halts, 2 steps, halts, 3 steps and halts. The dog heels with the handler and sits each time the handler halts.
- *Spiral Right:* The handler, with dog in heel, makes a sequence of right turns around a line of 3-4 pylons, with the first two turns around the end pylons and each successive turn on one end getting tighter and tighter.
